## *Scarlet Rope Meaning*

The scarlet rope represented salvation through the Blood and the peace that comes with it. It also represented that her old deeds were wiped clean by her using the same rope that got the spies out of the city, was also placed in her window for protection. THE ROPE SIGNIFIES YOU SAVED THEM, NOW YOU CAN BE SAVED! It's a reminder of what God did for His people with Christ through His love and compassion.
